Inside the longhouse, watch as whole salmon are cooked over an alder-wood fire on cedar stakes in the traditional Northwest Coast Indian style. Our meal will be served banquet style and consists of Traditional Alder Baked Salmon, Northwest Stew, Wild Grain Harvest Rice, Warm Whole Grain Tillicum Bread, Field Green Salad, Three Bean Salad, Fresh Fruit Salad and Chocolate Chunk Brownie with Marionberry Swirl for dessert. Vegetarian options are available. As we finish our meal, the lights dim while the myth and magic come to life in the spellbinding performance of Dance on the Wind, featuring dances in the spirit of coastal tribes.
