## **PROGRAMS:**

July 14th Dinner Meeting: Our Program was our new King Lion making committee assignments and planning the new Lion Year out.

July 28th Dinner Meeting we presented five Scholarships to students and parents in attendance. This year we awarded 8 Scholarships at \$ 750.00 each. Only five of the students could attend the dinner meeting.

Eyeglass Recycling Operations continue on Wednesday evenings and Thursday mornings on-site at the Park West Community Building. In the month of JULY we spent 66 Lion Hours by Park-West Lions processing glasses for our next shipment to Falls Church. Park-West Lions took in 737 pair of glasses to be recycled. 45 from Park-West Lions, 135 pair from the Manassas Lioness Lions, 321 pair from the Signal Hill Lions and 237 pair from the Woodbridge Lions. Also the Manassas Lioness Lions worked 10 hours at recycling of the glasses. The Community Center Building was provided for this activity at a value of \$ 2,500 and 30 Lion Hours. Lion Owen Williams and Bob Kirk spent 4 Lion Hours transporting members of the VIP Support Group. Donated use of the Community Center to the Vision Impaired People Support Group, valued at \$250.00 and 3 Lion Hours. ( 2 Lions worked this)
