ENTRY AND JUDGING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Scrapbook submission:** Deposit scrapbook on the designated table in the state convention exhibition area by 10:00 AM, on Saturday, May 23, 2009. Entry can include only ONE scrapbook no thicker than two and a half (2.5) inches - not counting the front and back cover - with pages no larger than twelve (12) inches wide and twelve (12) inches high. Only scrapbooks for current Lions year 2008-2009 can be submitted. Scrapbooks must be picked up from the exhibition area by 4:00 PM, on Saturday, May 23, 2009.
2. **Judging of scrapbooks:** The MD-24 General Chairperson of the Public Relations Committee will be responsible for conducting the judging of scrapbooks in accordance with the criteria listed above and will present a tally card to each club which shows exactly how many points were given for each item. When the MD24 PR-PA Chair cannot obtain enough committee members to assist with judging, the Chair will make the selections and will not provide a scoring tally card to contestants. **First- and second-place awards will be presented at the Saturday afternoon general session by the MD-24 PR Chairperson.**
